## II. Rules and Procedures for Delegate Assembly

- A. It is recommended that resolutions and position statements be submitted to the Delegate Assembly Steering Committee Chair and SAM Office by June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- B. Delegate affiliates will be allowed time to formulate resolutions and position statements prior to Delegate Assembly at an affiliate caucus.
- C. All voting shall be by show of hands or color cards of the delegates.
- D. Resolutions and position statements receiving a three-fourths (3/4) majority of those present and voting shall be deemed passed and will be presented to the annual SAM business meeting for final consideration.
- E. Resolutions and position statements not receiving three-fourths (3/4) majority shall be deemed to have failed.
- F. Members of the School Administrators of Montana may attend and speak to any issue being considered by the Delegate Assembly.
