## Highlights of Week 1 (Jan 7-11)

The <u>SAMLN19 Schedule: Week 1</u> outlines the schedule of events and hearings on bills for the week. This schedule also outlines the stance of SAM (Proponent, Opponent, or Monitor) in the Comment section for each bill to be heard.

Monday through Friday of the first week of the session will consist of mainly orientation and organization meetings of the House and Senate, and the respective committees. The <u>SAMLN19 Schedule: Week 1</u> lists the committee meetings scheduled and references to the bills being heard. Clicking on the Bill Number will send you directly to the LAWS website where the Bill Action progress report is posted. The actual bill language can be obtained by clicking on the hyper link or PDF link at the top of the Bill Action page.

MT-PEC (leadership of MASBO, MFPE, MQEC, MREA, MTSBA and SAM) are meeting on Tuesday, Jan 8 to discuss the current status of bills impacting education. We intend to keep you informed of progress on the issues under consideration by MT-PEC as the session progresses.

On Wednesday, Jan 9, MT-PEC partners are meeting with the Governor to discuss the Governor's budget proposal and pending legislation. Also on Wednesday, Jan 9, at about 3:00 pm a Joint meeting of the House and Senate Education Committees has invited SAM to attend for introductions and organizational purposes. I will be given an opportunity to introduce the legislators on both committees to SAM, our purpose and goals for advocacy. I will also be presenting the RISE4MT Update on recruitment and retention of quality educators for Montana progress and anticipated legislative support.



On Friday, Jan 11 a continuation of the Joint meeting of the House and Senate Education Committees is expected. Since most bills followed by SAM will be heard in these committees we intend on providing information to the joint committees upon request at the meeting on Friday.

## Upcoming Week 2 (Jan 14-18)

A Draft SAMLN19 Schedule for Week 2 will be prepared for your review later this week.
