Highlights of Week 11 (Mar 18 – Mar 23)

More than 50 school administrators and another 50 trustees gathered in Helena on Monday, March 18 to advocate for MT public education during the MT-PEC Day of Advocacy. Thank you to all who took the time to provide testimony, attend hearings, share your story with legislators, and build relationships that positively impact the students you serve. Bills signed by the Governor this week: <u>HB 247 (Grubbs)</u> Provide greater flexibility for school districts in financing major maintenance- Support (SAM Priority Bill); <u>HB 153 (Kelker)</u> Generally revise education laws related to gifted and talented programs.

Upcoming Week 12 (Mar 25 – Mar 30)

SAM Followed Bills 3-22-19 are up to 123 with 260 bill drafts being monitored. SAM Followed Bills Priority Status 3-22-19 describes the status of bills under the SAM advocacy priorities – Support Adequate and Equitable School Funding (21 bills), Support Recruitment and Retention of Quality Educators (5 bills), Oppose Privatization with Public Funds (0 bills), Support Facility and Technology Infrastructure (4 bills), Support School Based Mental Health Services (5 bills), and a new category of Other SAM Followed Bills (39 bills).
