



#### TEACHER-PREP ENROLLMENT TRENDS BY STATE





#### Preservice Teachers' Insights


- I used to think that it was never an option, but now I think that it might be an option. Just depends how rural.



- 9,270 students participated
- 60 certified YAM Instructors trained
- 28 schools participating
- 4 certified YAM Trainers
