- Supported by Dennis and Phyllis Washington Foundation, FREE for all (adults, homeschool, private, etc). True until 2022
- Colleges are saying kids aren't doing well in math. They go 18-24 months without math instruction (if they are done after their Sophomore year). Use EdReady rather than go into remediation
- EdReady is usable down to 4th grade level. Is aligned with <u>ACT</u> and Montana standards
- Can use for differentiation, blended learning, challenge track/pathway
- Use EdReady to show teachers ways to present (as PD)
- Use for enrichment, challenge, G/T
