The *vision* of the Montana Schools Recruitment Committee is to assist school districts and cooperatives locate and hire highly qualified special education personnel in the areas of need. The recruitment committee was developed in 2005 with the primary goal of increasing the pool of candidates for special education positions, giving administrators choices when hiring. Many small districts and cooperatives do not have human resources departments, so we are here to help.

Goals for this year 2017-2018:

DATA ON OUR RECRUITMENT PROJECT

1. How many schools/coops you are working with *We had 33 districts/cooperatives actively searching for candidates for 2017-18 school year positions and we already have 5 signed up for the 2018-2019 school year.*
2. Number of positions trying to fill *82 positions posted for the 2017-2018 school year*
3. Number of candidates registered with MCASE recruitment
 - a. Sped teacher *32 currently looking for 2017-18, 12 will be looking for 2018-19*
 - b. School psych *58 for 2017-18; 10 for 2018-19*
 - c. OT *19 for 2017-18; 22 for 2018-19*
 - d. PT *1 for 2018-19*
 - e. SLP *63 for 2017-18; 3 for 2018-19*
 - f. Directors *13 for 2017-18; 2 for 2018-19*
4. How many events attended *We are attending 15 live events to travel to and we are working on setting up a virtual career fair nationwide. This number can and usually does change, as we are either invited to something or something cancels. We check on the budget quarterly and the committee makes these decisions.*
5. How many current districts are registered with you? *21 schools/12 cooperatives registered last year*
6. Is the goal still to have filled enough positions to only have 20 districts/coops registered with you? *This number was thrown out just to be our base, as if we got at least this number of schools, we should be financially stable. It is the number we used in our financial formula.*

Another positive fact, this was the first year we had a school or a cooperative join the recruitment project every month.
